### **2006-2007 School Safety Statistics**

### **Accomplishments:**

**School Safety Assessments:** 7 Districts/40 Schools

### **Training:**

Conducted or sponsored workshops wherein 3,456 personnel were trained at no cost to the school district or department. Workshops and conference subjects included:

- School Safety Planning
- Crisis Response Plan Development
- School Law and Policy Development
- Restraint Techniques and Issues for Educators
- Oleoresin Capsicum Certification
- School Safety Assessment
- Administrative Investigations
- Juvenile Threat Assessment Protocol

Conducted training at 22 state, regional or national conferences. Training also includes training for 175 School Resource Officers and 190 School Safety Officers.

Staff also were asked to serve on the US Secretary of Education's Pandemic Task Force, the US Department of Education's Emergency Response and Crisis Management Technical Assistance Center as well as the Federal Post Trauma Stress in Children Working Group.
